Landon Potter (student) and Lawson Potter (junior) are spending the summer on Lopez with family. Welcome these excellent young golfers to our club.

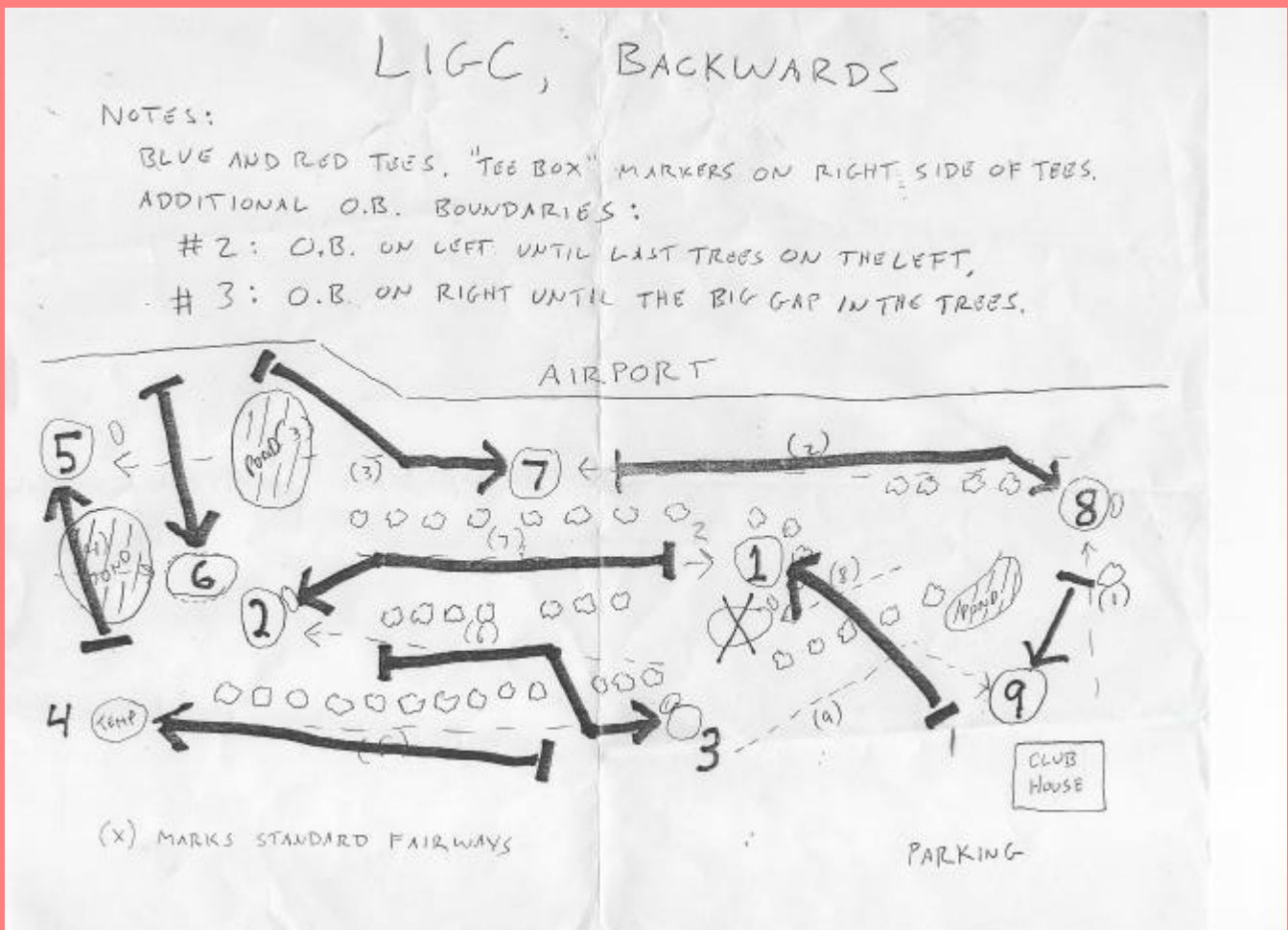

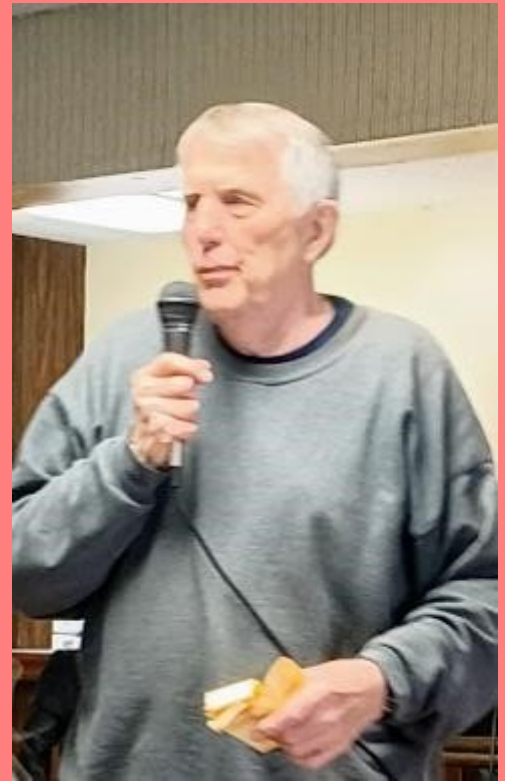
The event was followed by our first potluck dinner of the season. See pictures on the following pages.
