### Introducing the Tee Box Renovation Team

We have put together a Tee Box Renovation Team (TBRT) to evaluate the condition of the tee boxes and prioritize rebuilding the tees based on several criteria. The goal is to install the first newly renovated tee box in April 2021. The tee box renovation will cost approximately \$2,000. We will be installing it to



golf course standards: two inches of drain rock, then four inches



of sand and eight inches of topsoil. It is our hope that the members will like what we do in 2021 and will want us to do a new tee box every year with a ten year plan to complete all tees. In 2021 we plan to use \$1,500 of budgeted course improvement funds and plan to raise the difference needed for the project via donations. To

start, members of the TBRT will each donate \$100 and do all the work themselves. If the first new tee box is approved and then installed by



mid-April we expect to be able to play on it by late June. The team met with the RGHT (Rules, Green, Handicap, Tournament) committee to pitch the project. The RGHT committee then asked the Board for approval which was granted. The team working on the project is comprised of Mark Reisinger, Kit Ledbetter, Steve Bryson, Eric Meng and Scott Jennings.
