Winter Golf Cart Care

Winter servicing Golf Carts

Not unlike other times of the year, the most significant issue is batteries if the cart is so equipped, although gas carts do have batteries for starting and need some care. The one thing I see most often is corrosion of the battery terminals and the sub-structure in the cart. This needs to be cleaned with baking soda, making sure that the caps are on tight before doing this. Mix baking soda with water to a milky consistency not too thick as you will be painting this on with a brush. Make sure your cart is outside near a water faucet and hose. Paint the baking soda on all the terminals and battery tops letting the liquid flow down the side onto the sub-structure. Keep doing this until it stops bubbling. Rinse it off with water and dry the terminals. Now apply the red battery terminal protector liberally (this can be obtained at NAPA). Next check the water level inside the batteries and make sure the water covers the plates but **DO NOT** top off the batteries with water prior to charging them as it will overflow as the battery is charged!!! You are now ready to charge the batteries fully! This is an important step as a drained battery can and will freeze. After your batteries are fully charged, disconnect the positive terminal from the battery and set aside until spring, also disconnecting the charging cord. If you have a newer EZgo cart, flip the switch to the tow position. This should carry the cart until spring, at which time a thorough service can be done. Air up your tires, so when you return in the spring you are not dealing with flat tires that make it hard to get to the air hose. Finally it's a good idea to cover seats, as birds and other creatures deposit stuff on them in the winter.

Remember, battery acid is caustic and dangerous. A spark can cause an explosion and acid can and will burn you. Use gloves and eye protection and wear old clothes.

This advice is a result of 60 years of working on or watching others work on cars/carts etc... It is my opinion and is by no means authoritative or cast in concrete. Use it at your own discretion. Dick Bangsund
