Workday June 24

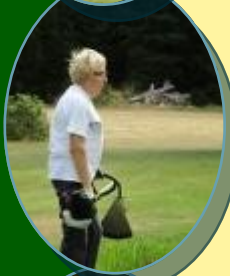
Great work was done this month on work day by 24 members:
